




Why Seal Paving?

The team at Block Blitz have over 85 years combined experience in the paving industry. From installation and maintenance, to paving manufacture and sales. They believe the misconception that paving needs sealing is widespread amongst customers, installers and retailers and that sealing paving is an additional unnecessary cost that comes with unhighlighted negatives. People are however looking for a way to achieve a maintenance free surface and may have previous experience of the constant struggle to keep an exterior paved surface looking clean and tidy.

So, we can see why the sealing industry is such a big market. However, when you speak to the manufacturers of paving, very few if any recommend sealing any of their products, especially in an outdoor location. Why is this? Well basically there is no advantage to sealing paving. The team at Block Blitz believe there are only two valid reasons to seal. Firstly, if the customer wants a permanent wet look/ glossy finish to the surface. Secondly, commercial paving that is undercover and not exposed directly to the elements. Commercial paving which is undercover or inside would be potentially easier to clean and resist soiling and staining from foot and vehicular traffic and discarded litter etc.

To recap, any paving (even sealed) that is exposed to the elements will eventually start to develop algae, fungi, moss and other organic growth. It will also accumulate various forms of dirt and grime.




